Summary of Academic and Administrative Audit 2012-13 to 2016-17

Observations:

1. The institution follows the curriculum developed by affiliating University. There are few elective options at entry level as well as at final year of UG and PG programme.
2. The institution follows Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and provides academic flexibility for PG final year students with the choice of elective courses.
3. Enrichment courses namely 'Application of Remote Sensing and GIS in Carbon Forestry' and 'Application of Geo-informatics in Forest Fire Management' are run by Department of Geography.
4. Feedback on curriculum has been conducted periodically from students and communicated to Board of Studies of affiliating University time to time.
5. The social awareness is achieved through NSS activities and the gender equity issues are addressed through Gender Sensitivity Programme. The environment awareness rallies and environment related programmes are regularly organized in the college.
6. Enrolment of students is done on merit basis and all statutory reservation norms are strictly followed by the college.
7. Slow learners are identified at entry level by conducting classroom tests as well as orals and remedial teaching programmes are organized for them by college. Special guidance and motivation is provided to advanced learners to prepare them for participation in various competitions.
8. The College prepares Academic Calendar at the beginning of the academic year and it is followed as per schedule.
9. The college has 14 number of ICT enabled class-rooms/laboratories with necessary facilities and Internet access.
10. At present college has 15 number of teachers with Ph.D. and 34 number of teachers with NET/SET.
11. Teachers are aware of POs, PSOs, and COs and are communicated to the students.
12. The college regularly conducts internal tests and term end examination of UG students and for choice based credit system continuous assessment is undertaken for PG students as per guidelines by affiliating University.

13. Results of maximum departments are upto the mark.
14. Feedback on teachers' assessment by students is conducted by college every year and analysis report is communicated to concerned teachers for corrective measures.
15. Teachers are involved in research activity have been generated research funds worth Rs.16,66,000 through research projects and 240 research papers have been published at reputed national/international journals.
16. Students have regularly participated in Avishkar research project competitions at University level.
17. Social activities, tree plantation are regularly conducted by college through NSS and NCC students. The college has adopted 'Narayan Tembhi' village for extension activities.
18. Teachers of college are active member of 'Cyclist Association' and conducts cycle expedition to spread message of Green eco-friendly environment.
19. The college has adequate infrastructure facilities as per University norms.
20. The central library has 42587 books and procured 71 research journals and e-journals.
21. Library management System is automated with OPAC.
22. There are 110 number of computers, 43 printers with internet bandwidth of 10 Mbps. The campus Wi-fi enabled with 13 routers/access points.
23. 40.23 percentage of students have received scholarships from different governing bodies.
24. Well developed sport facilities for students and 147 number of students have participated at international, national and state levels.
25. The college has received 'Best NSS Unit' and 'Best NSS Program Officer' awards by the University.
26. The vision, mission, objectives and goal of the institution are well defined in tune with the objectives of higher education.
27. Birth Anniversaries of Scientists, Leaders etc. are celebrated and programmes to inculcate values among students are also organized.
28. The college has functional IQAC, College Development Committee, Research Committee, Grievance Redressal Cell etc. for smooth conduct of academic and administrative work.
29. Different welfare schemes like 'Sevak Kalyan Nidhi', 'Medical Insurance', 'Loan facilities through credit societies' etc. are provided to the staff.
30. IQAC meetings are conducted regularly and AQARs are regularly submitted.
31. Well-developed mechanism for mobilization of resources.
32. Best practices identified are Soft-skill development for students and Coaching for Canoeing.
33. The college has safe and secure environment and whole campus has CCTV surveillance. This year enrolment of girl students is 61.26 %.
34. Rooftop rain water is collected through rain water harvesting system and utilized in laboratories. Solar Panel water heating system with 6000 LPD is installed and functional.

Recommendations/Comments

1. Research centres for some departments such as Chemistry, Commerce and Marathi should be established.
2. Collaborations resulting in functional MoUs can be done.
3. Introduce more skill development programmes.
4. Separate Maintenance committee should be appointed for maintenance of infrastructural facilities.
5. Training and Placement Cell should be strengthened.
6. Alumni Association should be registered as per norms and more funds can be generated through alumni contribution.
7. Teachers' enrichment programmes should be regularly conducted.
8. Facilities for Divyangjan students should be increased.
9. Mentoring system should be strengthened to create confidence among students.
10. The college should conduct 'Green Audit'
11. The college should think of setting up innovation and incubation centre to promote innovations, entrepreneurship and start-ups.
12. Workshops may be conducted for teachers on topics such as MOOCs, Role of ICT in teaching to promote use of ICT in teaching, learning and evaluation.
