Procedures for Taking Feedback

The college regularly collects feedback from its stakeholder viz. students, teachers, alumni, parents and management. Feedback is collected through sample feedback forms. Feedback is considered necessary for the improvement and sustenance of quality of curriculum, infrastructure and allied services.

Student Feedback: Every year at the end of the second term or semester, feedback from students regarding the curriculum and teaching-learning-evaluation process is collected.

Alumni Feedback: At the Alumni Meet, feedback forms are circulated and collected.

Teacher Feedback: Teachers' feedback is taken about the course. Students' feedback about the teacher is also sought.

Parents Feedback: Parents feedback is collected at the parents meet. It is also circulated among students to bring the feedback from their parents as a regular activity.

Management Feedback: Feedback from the Management representatives is collected during the LMC meetings.

Analysis of Feedback

The collected feedback is analyzed by the members of IQAC. Important suggestions and recommendations are noted down. The grades and marks given in the feedback forms are recorded. The analysis of the feedback is presented before the IQAC committee for initiating appropriate action. The IQAC members approved the feedback analysis and initiate the process to convey the analysis to the concerned authorities and persons. The analysis is shared with the respective heads of the departments. If there are any complaints regarding the teaching, support services and infrastructure, it is conveyed to the concerned department. Curriculum related suggestions are conveyed to the respective Boards of Studies, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.
